Special Events

Since our last Newsletter, there have been some special events that the children have been taking part in:-

- a) Last Monday, we held a fabulous workshop day as part of the YDNP's "Dark Skies" project. Kat Kilner, one of the YDNP's rangers in our area, and 2 of her colleagues, came into school to lead a day's activities about space and what we can see in the sky. The product of the children's work will be on display in the National Park Centre during half-term week do visit if you have the chance to do so. The children have also taken home a leaflet outlining the many other activities that the YDNP are organising during the coming weeks.
- b) On Thursday last week, it was great for all the Class 2 children to benefit from Mr. Paul Forrow's (one of our parents) experience and knowledge in computer programming. Paul will be coming into school each Thursday to teach the children how to programme computers, beginning with "Scratch".





c) Many of the children in Class 2 took part in the cluster indoor athletics event on Friday at Giggleswick School. They all competed with great enthusiasm in a range of athletics events, and were a credit to the school. Overall in the team competitions, the Yrs 3&4 girls and the Yrs 5&6 boys each came 4th, the Yrs 3&4 boys came 5th, and the Yrs 5&6 girls came 6th. In order to have a Yrs 5&6 girls team, our Yr 4 girls moved up an age group, and did very well competing against girls who in many cases were 2 years older. - d) On Thursday this week, 2nd February, we welcome local artist Stephen Waterhouse to school. Stephen, a children's illustrator, will lead a day's workshop designing a mural for the school playground, which we hope will be unveiled at a special event just before the Easter holiday.
- e) The PTA's Supper Night, including an Auction of Promises, is taking place at the Farm Shop in Airton on the evening of Saturday 11th February. Please contact one of the PTA committee if you would like to book a place, and/or offer a promise to be auctioned.
- f) On Friday of next week, 10th March, we are holding a "Wear Red for SELFA" day. SELFA (or Skipton Extended Learning For All) is an organisation whose vision is to provide a range of activities and events "where vulnerable, disadvantaged and disabled children and young people experience happiness and belonging". Our link with SELFA is that Sam, who comes into school every Wednesday afternoon to teach PE, is a member of the SELFA staff. We would like to do something to support











the work that SELFA undertakes, and so on Friday 10th we are asking the children to come to school dressed in nonschoolwear in red and denim, and to pay £1. Further information about SELFA's work can be seen on their website.

Communications

Accelerated Reader

Many parents already receive email updates of their children's progress in the Accelerated Reader scheme. These emails are generated automatically children complete one of the schemes quizzes about a book they have just read. Accelerated Reader is administered by Renaissance Learning, and Renaissance Home Connect allows parents to:-

- View student targets, results of the last quiz taken, overall progress on Reading Practice Quizzes and a list of words learned on Vocabulary Practice Quizzes.
- Find books that have Accelerated Reader quizzes by clicking the AR BookFinder link.
- View the Bookshelf (which shows books read and quiz results).
