## Internet Safety Day

We held our Internet Safety and Awareness Day on Monday of this week – a day earlier than the national (and international) events because of our internal arrangements. The focus for the day in Class 1 was 5 Rules for Internet Safety. In Class 2, the focus was the use of images, where the children learnt about how to use pictures responsibly, and the dangers and problems that can occur if they aren't. The Yr 4, 5 and 6 children presented a play to the other children which followed the consequences of the actions of a boy who used the internet – and particularly shared pictures – sometimes responsibly, and sometimes less so.
